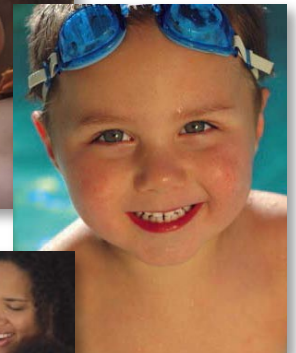

Allergy Testing & Treatment

Patients over 7 experiencing symptoms such as frequent sinus or ear infections, post nasal drainage, rhinitis or trouble breathing through the nose may find allergy testing beneficial to find the underlying cause. Inhalant allergies can be treated with traditional injections or sublingual drops administered at home.
